

Remington College's Heathrow Campus (Online Programs) ("Remington College") is not regulated in Texas under Chapter 132 of the Texas Education Code.

Remington College is licensed by the Commission for Independent Education, Florida Department of Education. Remington College holds a Non Resident Institution Certificate of Approval issued by the Alabama Commission on Higher Education and is licensed by the Alabama Community College System pursuant to the Alabama Private School License Law. The Private School License must be renewed every two years and is based on an evaluation concerning quality of education, ethical and business practices, health and safety, and fiscal responsibility.

In Alaska, Remington College is exempt from authorization under AS 14.48 and 20 AAC 17 because the program is online or distance delivered and does not have a physical presence in the state.

Remington College is registered as an out-of-state distance education provider to enroll residents of Pennsylvania in the Business Administration, Criminal Justice, Health Information Management, Health Information Technology, Organizational Management and Paralegal programs.

Remington College is authorized by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. This authorization must be renewed each year and is based on an evaluation by minimum standards concerning quality of education, ethical business practices, health and safety, and fiscal responsibility. State licensure does not constitute accreditation, guarantee the transferability of credit, nor signify that programs are certifiable by any professional agency or organization.
