# Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Report – Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

### July 9, 2021

Remington College (OPE ID: 030265) received education stabilization funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), Public Law No: 116-136. This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

The institution appreciates that Congress and the President have made these critical funds available for eligible students who have expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus pandemic. We take receipt of these federal funds seriously and are distributing them in accordance with the CARES Act and implementing guidance.

The institution is making the below information available for transparency purposes and in compliance with the U.S. Department of Education's ("Department") Notice of Public Posting Requirement of Grant Information for Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Grantees published on August 31, 2020. - 1. The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$6,704,434.
- 3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of this Fund Report is \$5,226,250. Of that amount, \$0 was distributed for the quarter period of April 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, and thus eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act, as of June 30, 2021 is **8,518**.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an emergency financial aid grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of June 30, 2021 is **2,819**.
- 6. The methods used by the institution to determine which students receive emergency financial aid grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act are provided at **Attachment A**.
- 7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the emergency financial aid grants are provided at **Attachment B**.

### Attachment A

Title: CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Policy and Procedure

Effective Date: April 30, 2020

### **Policy**

It is the policy of Remington College to comply with all requirements of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) in processing the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds available under the CARES Act.

### **Background and Procedures**

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) through the Department of Education has made Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds available to both students and institutions for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

### A. STUDENT PORTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUNDS

### What is the CARES Act?

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act includes a Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). The Department of Education has made emergency funding available to Remington College that must go directly to students in the form of emergency financial aid grants (EFA Grants), for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the COVID-19 crisis, including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare, and child-care expenses.

### **Student Eligibility:**

### Which students are eligible to receive HEERF – student emergency financial aid funds?

Students must meet Title IV eligibility requirements, be an active student in good standing, and must have expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus in order to be eligible for emergency financial aid funds.

Title IV eligible students must:

- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a degree or certificate program.
- o For currently enrolled students, be making satisfactory academic progress.
- Not owe an overpayment on Title IV grants or loans.
- O Not be in default on a Title IV loan.
- File "as part of the original financial aid application process" a certification that includes
  - A statement of educational purpose
  - Student's SSN
- $\circ$  Be a US citizen or national, permanent resident, or other eligible noncitizen.
- Have returned fraudulently obtained Title IV funds if convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to charges.

- Not have fraudulently received Title IV loans in excess of annual or aggregate limits.
- o Have repaid Title IV loan amounts in excel of annual aggregate limits if obtained inadvertently.
- o Have Selective Service verified.
- Have Social Security Number verified.
- o Not have a federal or state conviction for drug possession or sale, within certain time limitations.

### **Award Amount:**

The Award Amount for each student is \$1,850.00.

### **Student Groups:**

Remington College has identified Title IV eligible students for each campus, they are put into student groups.

Students who are enrolled in online only programs or students who are not actively enrolled at the time they are to receive the emergency financial aid funds are not eligible to receive emergency financial aid funds.
